When you just want to sit back and enjoy the pure tastes of Sangiovese and Tuscany, it hardly gets better than Luigi Anania's La Torre. The 2013 Brunello di Montalcino is a direct and streamlined wine that keeps tight focus on the typicity and character of this important grape. This is a graceful and delicate expression with bright notes of wild berry, blue violets and rain-soaked earth. This vintage shows extra brightness and focus. The mouthfeel is sleek and super silky (albeit slightly thinner than past editions). A big hail storm hit the vineyards this vintage and production was reduced as a result. Only 4,000 bottles were made.
