The 2016 Brunello di Montalcino opens up with an earthy and almost-herbal quality, yet it Montalcino quickly gains freshness through a display of peppery florals, bright strawberry and dusty

cedar. The textures are silky with a polished and soothing feel, propelled by lively acids which combine with the wine's inner sweetness to create a balanced and fully satisfying expression. Ripe cherry, raspberry and hints of tobacco linger long over a coating of fine tannins. As structured and youthful as this is, the 2016 Brunello from La Torre never loses

its energetic feel. I hope to be able to revisit this in five to ten years, because it's packed full

of potential. -- Eric Guido
