La Torre 2018 Brunello di Montalcino 94

Deep red. Perfumed, sweetly spicy nose of superripe red cherries, strawberry nectar and candied violets; this is bordering dangerously on being overripe, but there's no denying the charm of this ample sweet nose. Then bright and juicy, but with very rich dense red fruit and sweet spice flavours (cinnamon, nutmeg) complicated by peppery and tarry elements. Finishes long and mouthcoating with deep repeating nuances of spicy red fruit. One of the wines of the vintage. Drinking window: 2028-2036.
